#### Welcome!

Thanks for purchasing a Gamer Concepts Mechanist line of model kits.

#### Materials Needed:

- Sandpaper. Some is included but you may need more if you go all out and put a finish on it. 220, 320 or 400 grit is good.
- A tealight or some other wax (included). Beeswax is too sticky. Regular candle wax should do.
- A sharp utility knife.
- A hammer, a screwdriver handle or medium sized rock to set some of the tighter joints into place.

### A few guidlines:

Some parts separate from the wood sheets easily. Some will need a little help with a knife, especially the smaller parts.


Moving parts will need a little sanding and waxing to ensure smooth movement.

In the directions; blue lines denote waxing, red lines are to be sanded, and purple lines are both.

Due to the inconsistancy of plywood these strange days, once in a while a joint might be too loose.


A little bit of glue goes a long way. I use FastCap 2P10 superglue but any super or wood glue will work.






If you are having trouble getting a part out, use a utility blade or hobby knife to cut any points that look like this from the back of the sheets.































































